

Dear Parents / Carers

You will have read in the school newsletter that we are planning a day of fun and celebration for the children at the end of the first half of Summer Term. Part of the day will involve a Sponsored Colour Run at 2.30 p.m. to raise money for the school, which will help us to update our school library area.

A colour run is a non-competitive fun run where participants are splashed with coloured powder at various points along the route. The focus is on fun and enjoyment, rather than speed or performance. If pupils do not wish to take part, they are more than welcome to sit and watch; as it will be very entertaining! FS1 pupils will be welcome to attend if they do not usually attend on a Friday.

Parents/carers are invited to join their child/ren!

We are asking for £5 sponsorship for each participating child or adult. We welcome additional sponsorship and will be giving a prize to the top 3 fundraising families. We have set up a payment item on Parent Pay in which you can pay the £5 entry and any additional sponsorship money. It is set to a variable amount in order for you to input the total amount paid in. Please can this be paid by the day of the event, Friday 22nd May.

The waiver form will need to be signed and returned to school by Friday 8th May to ensure you / your child can take part.

Your child has now been provided with a paper copy of the waiver and sponsor form.

Participants will need a white t-shirt that you don't mind getting messy and protective eyewear is essential, however we have been informed that glasses / sunglasses etc are sufficient. We will be selling sunglasses and other merchandise in school from Monday 11th May. *Pupils should wear their PE kit, with the white t-shirt being the most important element.* The coloured powder will wash out of clothes. Pupils who suffer from asthma will be kept a close eye on, with inhalers taken outside.
