Rail Safety

Children have shared the information below regarding the importance of Rail Safety. Please always ensure that children are aware of the extreme dangers when near to rail lines. The features below can be accessed free online.

Key Stage 1:

Our Key Stage 1 programme is an interactive session that features a live-read of 'Arlo's Adventures - There And Back' from the author, Bessie Matthews, who is a train driver for GB Railfreight. The 'pick a path' book is designed to help young people understand the risks of the railway, so they can stay safe.

Key Stage 2:

Our Key Stage 2 programme is an interactive session that features Harrison's Story. 11-year-old Harrison tragically lost his life when he was electrocuted by overhead power cables after straying into a rail freight depot to retrieve a football. The video also includes an interactive rail safety quiz and a rap for your class to learn.
