In addition, our new school tracksuit is now available to purchase from the uniform shop. Parents and carers may purchase the new school-branded tracksuit or choose a plain all-black tracksuit that meets the school's uniform requirements.

Please keep your voucher safe, as it will be required when collecting your child's new PE top. We look forward to all pupils being ready for September in their new PE kit.
